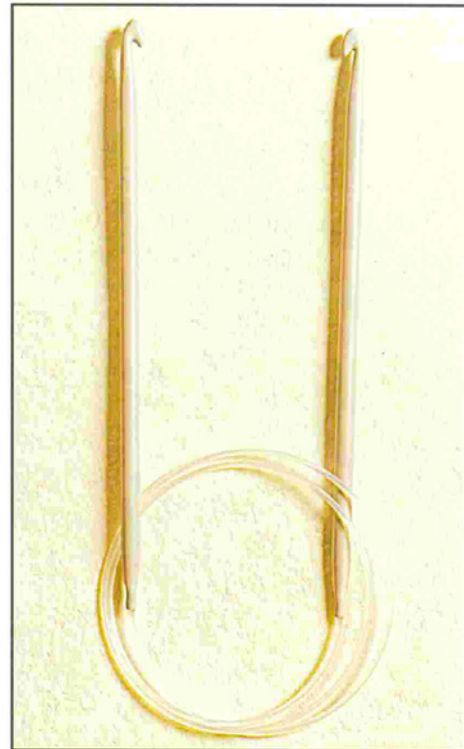


CIRCULAR CROCHET HOOKS

- Ideal for all crochet work - shawls & stoles, dresses, blankets, rugs, mats and waistcoats and many many more.



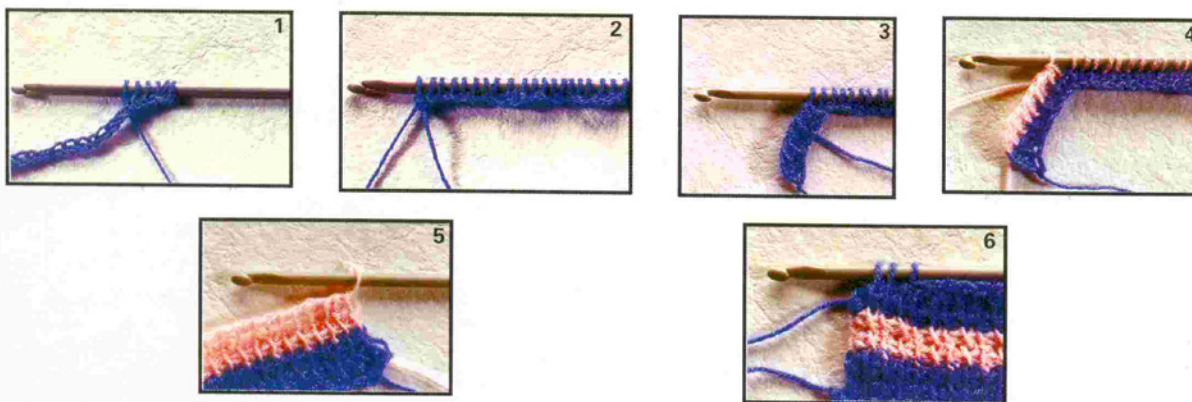

HOW TO USE A PAIR OF CIRCULAR CROCHET HOOKS

These hooks are used like an Afghan or Tunisian hook. Loops are all picked up on the hook in one row and worked off the hook in the next. The resulting fabric is interestingly thick and cuddly, somewhat like a knitted garter stitch.

1. To draw up a loop: Insert hook in designated loop, vertical bar or stitch, yarn over, draw loop through (see illustrations 1 and 4), leaving loop on hook.
2. When picking up loops : leave all loops on hook (see illustration 2) unless otherwise stated.
3. To work loops off hook : Yarn over, draw one loop on hook, next * (yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) * work from * to * across all sts. (see illustration 3)
4. Last loop remaining on hook at end is first vertical bar of next row. (see illustration 5)
5. To slip stitch in a vertical bar : Insert hook under specified vertical bar, yo, draw through bar and lp on hook. (see illustration 6).

INSTRUCTIONS FOR A MULTI-COURED SHAWL USING CIRCULAR CROCHET HOOKS.

Step by step instructions, to work a simple shawl in double knitting wool in 3 colours working through the vertical bars, are given below.

MATERIAL:

Double knitting wool: **main** colour 500 gms; **second** colour 300 gms; **third** colour 300 gms.

PONY Circular crochet hooks - one pair each. 5.00 mm and 5.50 mm.

FINISHED SIZE: 55 cm x 196 cm with tension of 8 stitches to 5 cm and 10 rows to 5 cm.

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch - chain **lp** - loop **st** - stitch **sc** - single crochet

turn - rotate work 180 degrees and slide all lps to opposite end

yo - yarn over.

sc lp - insert hook in next chain or vertical bar, yo, draw lp through, yo, draw through one lp on hook.

INSTRUCTIONS:

MAIN COLOUR

Row 1: With a 5.50 mm circular hook crochet 270 chain. sc lp in second chain from hook, next * (draw up lp in next ch, sc lp in next ch) * work from * to * across all sts.

Row 2: Work loops off hook.

Row 3: *Skip first vertical bar, sc lp in next vertical bar, next * (draw up lp in next vertical bar, sc lp in next vertical bar) * work from * to * across, **TURN**.

Cut main colour wool, leaving a 5 in (127 mm). length of main colour wool to form the fringe. If you prefer to do the fringe later, carry the wool weaving it loosely alongside the work, till you need to use it again.

SECOND COLOUR

Row 4: With second colour wool, place slip knot on hook, draw slip knot through first loop (of main colour) on hook, * (yo, draw through 2 loops on hook) * Work * to * across all sts, working loops off the hook.

Row 5: Follow Row 3. **DO NOT TURN**.

Row 6: Work loops off the hook.

Row 7: Follow Row 3. **TURN**.

MAIN COLOUR - Work rows 8 to 11 in main colour, the same as rows 4 to 7.

THIRD COLOUR - Work rows 12 to 15 in third colour, the same as rows 4 to 7.

Work in this colour sequence **main, second, main, third,** and **main** until the work measures 55 cm. or the width you want your shawl to be.

With 5.00 mm hook, ch 1, sc in next vertical bar, next * (slip st in next vertical bar, sc in next vertical bar) * work from * to * across all sts. Fasten off.

FRINGE:

Cut one strand same colour as colour section about 28 cm long or for length required. Fold it in half, insert hook in end of colour section, pull fold through, pull all loose ends through fold, tighten. Trim to required length.

If you have left lengths of wool for the fringe, you have to only fill in the gaps now.
